The 2016-2018 Markleevillage Fuels Reduction Project (Project) will treat 234 acres of a larger 1,200 acre plan. The project is located on the Carson Ranger District of the Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest, approximately 1.5 mile west of the town of Markleeville, California. This project is broken down in to two treatment areas. Treatment Area 1, also known as Pleasant Valley, contains 140 acres and will be treated between November 2016 and March 2017. Treatment Area 2, also known as Thornburg Canyon, contains 94 acres and will be treated between November 2017 and March 2018. Prescriptions will include the removal of heavy brush, small trees and under story fuels by
