

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that El Dorado Irrigation District (EID) (a) has concluded after preparing an Initial Study (IS) that the 2018 EID Temporary Water Transfer to Dudley Ridge Water District and Kern County Water Agency would not have a significant effect on the environment; (b) has prepared a proposed Negative Declaration (ND); and (c) will be recommending to the EID Board of Directors that it adopt the ND.

**PROJECT NAME:** 2018 El Dorado Irrigation District Temporary Water Transfer to Dudley Ridge Water District and Kern County Water Agency

**PROJECT LOCATION & DESCRIPTION:** EID proposes to transfer up to 5,000 acre-feet (AF) of water to Dudley Ridge Water District and Kern County Water Agency for use in their State Water Contractor service areas in southern Kings and Kern counties during summer and early fall 2018. EID would re-operate three of its reservoirs in western El Dorado County, northwestern Alpine County, and northeastern Amador County to release water otherwise planned for consumption by EID customers and/or stored within EID reservoirs. The proposed 5,000-AF of transfer water would be derived from a combination of available water sources in Weber Reservoir (up to approximately 800 AF), Caples Lake (up to approximately 2,800 AF), and Silver Lake (up to approximately 3,200 AF), that would otherwise be added to storage in Jenkinson Lake or used directly to meet summer/fall 2018 demands that would instead be met with water previously stored in Jenkinson Lake.

**DOCUMENT REVIEW & AVAILABILITY:** The 30-day public review period begins on May 18, 2018 and ends on June 17, 2018.
