## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

### **Alpine County Local Transportation Commission**

Regarding Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5311 funding for the purpose of purchasing a 7-passenger plus 1-wheelchair tie-down bus for the Dial-A-Ride public transit program

Notice is hereby given that the Alpine County Local Transportation Commission is proposing to apply for Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funds to purchase a public transit bus. The new bus is proposed to be a 7-passenger vehicle plus one wheelchair tie-down including a wheelchair lift. The new bus will replace the 2008 five-passenger minivan that has exceeded its useful life. The proposed new bus is estimated to cost approximately \$70,000 to be paid with FTA and local State Transit Assistance (STA) funds as match funding.

The Local Transportation Commission had scheduled a public hearing to discuss the purchase of the new transit bus for Tuesday, August 7, 2018 at 11:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, at the Alpine County Board Chambers, 99 Water Street, Markleeville, California.

However, during the last 15 days there were no requests received for a public hearing and the public hearing has been canceled.
