AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF ALPINE SUSPENDING REGISTRATION OF RESIDENTIAL SHORT-TERM RENTALS DURING THE MORATORIUM PERIOD

The Board of Supervisors adopted an interim Urgency Ordinance on March 17, 2020, which is a moratorium against residential short-term rentals for a period of forty-five (45) days. This is the first extension which shall be for ten months and 15 days.

The Board of Supervisors finds that the proposed first extension is not subject to California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to section 15060(c)(2) and 15060(c)(3) of California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3.

Any person interested may appear and be heard as to whether the Interim Urgency Ordinance should be extended for the first time, or on any other matter related to the extension of the Interim Urgency Ordinance. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Clerk of the Board in advance.
