

Natural vegetation, shrubs, branches, limbs, pine needles, grasses, leaves

*The drop off area is divided into two piles one for mixed vegetation and the other for pine needles/grasses/leaves.*

### **Not Accepted:**

Stumps, treated wood, wood with nails, non-vegetation items, rocks, dirt, cement, construction debris and construction site clearing debris, trash, garbage, household waste, furniture, tires, recyclable items, metals, appliances, plastics, batteries, oil, vehicles, paint, solvents, anti-freeze, paint thinners, cleaning fluids, aerosol cans, pesticides, insecticides
