TITLE: ADDENDUM: Discussion and direction regarding proposed Alpine County 2021 Reapportionment Maps.

SUMMARY: During the Board of Supervisor’s Strategic Planning meeting on November 8, 2021, an urgency item was placed by Supervisor Griffith for discussion and direction to staff and the redistricting commission to meet and bring back another map option.

The Redistricting Commission met on November 10, 2021 to propose additional options. Due to the narrow timeframe and complexity of preparing quality detailed census blocks/maps, the Commission report and maps will be distributed on Friday, November 12, 2021 as an addendum.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Selection of Alpine County 2021 Reapportionment Map.

Addendum to Alpine County Redistricting Advisory Commission Report

Every ten years, local governments use new census data to redraw their district lines to reflect how local populations have changed. Assembly Bill 849 (2019) requires cities and counties to engage communities in the redistricting process by holding public hearings and/or workshops and doing public outreach, including to non-English-speaking communities.

Districts must be redrawn so that each district is substantially equal in population, ensuring that each board member represents about the same number of constituents. In Alpine, the Board of Supervisors is responsible for drawing supervisorial districts. This year the state verified U.S. Census data for Alpine County was released September 19, 2021. The Alpine County redistricting process must be completed by December 15, 2021.

Redistricting determines which neighborhoods and communities are grouped together into a district for purposes of electing a board member. The Alpine County Redistricting Advisory Commission, which is made up of volunteer members of the public, has been working to develop fair and representative district maps for the Board of Supervisor's consideration.

Please see the Alpine County Redistricting Advisory Commission Report, available on the 2020 Redistricting website for further background material, comments and initial recommendations.

This Addendum includes subsequent considerations and recommendations of the Alpine County Redistricting Advisory Commission, as requested by the Board of Supervisors at their November 8, 2021, Strategic Planning Meeting. At this meeting, Supervisor Griffith expressed a concern that the current maps "dilute" the votes of the people of the Hung-A-Lel-Ti Community. The Board of Supervisors directed the Redistricting Advisory Commission to meet again and bring back another redistricting option specifically focusing on maintaining the integrity of the Hung-A-Lel-Ti Community, working within the confines of the population requirements and the census block numbers.

The Alpine County Redistricting Committee met on November 10, 2021. After discussion among Commission members and with County Counsel, the following is submitted for the Board of Supervisor's consideration:

Discussions, Conclusions and Recommendations

- The 2020 U.S. census configurations provide a challenge to separate the districts along natural geographic lines and Communities of Interest. The Advisory Commission discussed the Carson River area and determined that including these census blocks in District 3 does not appear to meet the requirement for contiguous geography. County Counsel may be able to clarify how the geographical definition of "contiguous" is interpreted as that informs the alternatives for district mapping.

- Alpine County's very low population numbers (1,207) makes implementation of the 10% population allocation among districts very limiting. In Alpine County, the percentage can be thrown off by 2 or 4 people. County Counsel clarified to the Redistricting Advisory Commission that the 10% variation is the limit under law and that this takes priority over district boundaries that reflect geographic and Community of Interest considerations.
- Because of growth in the north end of the County over the past 10 years, the population in all the areas that have expressed a desire to be included in District 5 exceed the 2020 redistricting population target of 241 for each district and the variation allowed by law.
- The integrity of the Hung-A-Lel-Ti Community remains respected and secured as a majority-minority district for elected representation in each of the district map options provided to the Board of Supervisors. There are two particular points that the Redistricting Advisory Commission concluded:
 - There are 215 American Indians reported for Alpine County in the 2020 census population numbers. There are not enough Hung-A-Lel-Ti Community members to reach the district target number of 241. In each of the mapping options, the Community member allocation for District 3, compared to non-Community members, is 75%, 72% and 77%, respectively. Overall, 84% of Hung-A-Lel-Ti Community members are represented in District 3. Others are represented in other County districts.
 - As a matter of historical reference, since it's inception as a majority-minority district, District 3 has always had non-Community members as part of the district. The Hung-A-Let-Ti Community Redistricting Advisory Commission member expressed that the Community has not viewed this as restricting its function as a majority-minority district nor as an impediment to working with all district residents. Additionally, all Hung-A-Lel-Ti Community members are members of and represented by the Hung-A-Lel-Ti Community Counsel for matters of both County and Tribal concern, regardless of their physical location throughout the County. Those located outside of District 3 boundaries are also represented by the Supervisor in their County district.

The Alpine County Redistricting Advisory Commission respectfully recommends the following considerations:

Alpine County Redistricting Advisory Commission Map Option #1

- This map represents an accurate representation of the real and authentic geographic areas that correspond to the Communities of Interest for our various communities, while conforming to the census block and population limitations. The Redistricting Advisory Committee voted that this is the least desirable option for approval.

Alpine County Redistricting Advisory Commission Map Option #2

- This map represents an accurate representation of the real and authentic geographic areas that correspond to the Communities of Interest of Alpine County. It is an alternative that provides for a more cohesive neighborhood in the Chambers Lane area. After discussion with County Counsel, the Commission voted to resubmit this map along with Options 1 and 3.

Alpine County Redistricting Advisory Commission Map Option #3

- This map was developed in response to the Board's direction of November 8, 2021. This map reflects an accurate representation of the real and authentic geographic areas that correspond to the Communities of Interest of Alpine County. This map shifts the boundaries of Districts 1, 3, and 5, remains within the population and census block perimeters, and increases the District 3 Hung-A-Lel-Ti Community population from 181 to 184.
- The Commission also recommends, in conjunction with discussion with County Counsel, that discussion and review of the redistricting process and options should be heard in open session.

The members of the Alpine County Redistricting Advisory Commission have been exceptionally engaged in this process. Members have all brought their own particular knowledge, expertise, skills, ethics and thoughtfulness in support of the Board of Supervisor's consideration for the 2020 U.S. Census redistricting process. 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


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

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Alpine County 2020 Census 2021 Reapportionment D1 - OPTIONS 1 & 2





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


D3 - OPTION 2**


