## SOCIAL SERVICES TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COUNCIL

Notice is hereby given that the Alpine County Local Transportation Commission is requesting applications for appointment to the Social Services Transportation Advisory Council (SSTAC) pursuant to the California Public Utilities Code Section 99238.

The SSTAC is comprised for the purposes defined in the Public Utilities Code Section 99238, including but not limited to review and evaluate unmet transit needs in the County.
