

**NOTICE OF VACANCY**

**ALPINE COUNTY FISH AND GAME COMMISSION**

Notice is hereby given that the Alpine County Board of Supervisors is requesting applications for appointments to the Alpine County Fish and Game Commission.

Seven (7) members shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors and shall serve at the pleasure of the Board for a four-year term to commence January 1st of the year in which they are appointed.

1. Five (5) members from within the following categories:

- Resident of Alpine County, California, with a primary domicile within the county limits; or
- Business owner with an active, legally recognized business operating within Alpine County; or
- Employee at a legally recognized business operating within Alpine County

Proof of Eligibility:

- *Residency shall be verified through documentation such as a valid California driver's license, voter registration, or utility bills indicating an Alpine County address.*
- *Business ownership shall be verified through documentation such as a business license, tax filings, or other official records demonstrating active business operations in Alpine County.*
- *Employment shall be verified through documentation such as a recent paystub, employee identification, tax filings or an official memo from the employer.*

2. Two (2) members at large:

There are five (5) vacancies on the Alpine County Fish and Game Commission for unexpired terms, four (4) positions beginning 01/01/2026 and ending 12/31/2029 and one (1) position with unexpired term ending 12/31/2026.

The purpose and objective of the Fish and Game Commission is to advise and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors concerning policies and procedures for the operation of the County Fish and Game system.

Applications will be accepted by the Alpine County Clerk, with appointments to be made at a regular meeting of the Alpine County Board of Supervisors.
