

NOTICE OF VACANCY

JUVENILE JUSTICE COORDINATING COUNCIL

Subject to general direction from the Board of Supervisors of the County of Alpine, State of California, Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council (JJCC) (Welfare & Institutions Code Section(s) 1990-1995), to allow maximum local flexibility within the statutory framework set forth in Senate Bill (SB) 823, with Subcommittee (s) to include; Juvenile Justice Realignment Grant(JJRBG) (Welfare & Institutions Code Section(s) 1990-1995), Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) (Government Code (GC) Section 30061(b)(4)(C) and, Youthful Offender Block Grant (YOBG) (Welfare & Institution Code (W&I) Section 1961(c). The legislation requires a local collaborative planning and implementation process which emphasizes community-based corrections and punishment, use of evidence-based practices, and improved supervision strategies put in place after the dissolution of the State Division of Juvenile Justice, for high level offenders.

Notice is hereby given that the Alpine County Board of Supervisors is requesting applications for public appointment to the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council for **one (1) Community Member**. A Community Member shall be defined as individuals or entities who have experience providing community-based youth services, youth justice advocates with expertise and knowledge of the juvenile justice system or have been directly involved in the juvenile justice system.

The Alpine County Clerk will accept applications for Community Members until the vacancies are filled. Appointment will be made at a regular meeting of the Alpine County Board of Supervisors.
