
**THE DEADLINE FOR FILING WRIT OF MANDATE
AUGUST 26, 2018***

THE LAW: California Elections Code section 13313 allows a ten-day public examination period of all candidate statements submitted for the official voter's pamphlet. A copy of the material is available for public examination in the elections official's office. Any person may obtain a copy of the candidate's statements from the elections official for use outside of the elections official's office; a fee for copies may be charged.

During this ten-day examination period, any voter of the jurisdiction in which the election is being held, or the elections official, himself or herself, may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the material in the voter's pamphlet to be amended or deleted.

PURPOSE: Candidates viewing their own, as well as other candidate's statements during the ten-day public examination period, and taking action during this time, helps to reduce errors and resolve differences before sample ballots are printed and distributed.
