Here is the **drive through testing schedule for the month of September:**

Bear Valley, every other Monday, 10AM – 1:30 PM, South Parking Lot, Aug 31, Sep 14 and 28

Kirkwood, every Wednesday, 11AM – 3:30 PM, Lower Red Cliffs Parking Lot, Sep 2, 9, 16, 23, 30

Woodfords, every Thursday, 11AM – 3PM, HHS Parking Lot, Sep 3, 10, 17, 24

Testing is FREE

We recommend testing every few weeks. It does not matter how many times you have been tested before – the testing only shows what is in your body on the day of the test.

Results are available within 3-5 days.

Always remember, if you have symptoms of fever, cough, and/or acute loss of taste and/or smell, be sure to contact us for consultation about your options for evaluation and testing.
